EBUFC Team Helpers (better if shared)

Role Description

Team helpers have minimal responsibilities as little or as much as you want, but they must carry out their role in a consistent manner.

To allow the coach to organise the squad on match days and training without the burden of additional setting up and administrative duties.

Commitment

Approx 1 hour per week depending on amount of helpers

Responsibilities

- 1. Assist with setting up and taking down the goals
- 2. Assist with setting up and taking down respect barriers
- 3. Putting out and collecting in corner flags
- 4. Collecting and documenting training/match fees
- 5. Running a tea hut either formally or informally
- 6. Assisting with collecting cones, bibs etc.
- 7. Monitor potential safeguarding issues i.e. coach left on their own
- 8. Referee or run the line if needed
- 9. Report any issues to the parent rep or manager.
- 10. To organise and hand out clothing as necessary
- 11. Help on events for the team and club

Constraints

The manager is responsible for the above however the helpers are there to maximise the coaching time and therefore player development.
