Team Parent Representative (better if shared)

Role Description

Team Parent Representatives have minimal responsibilities as little or as much as they want, but they must carry out their role in a consistent manner.

To allow the coach to organise the squad on match days and training without the burden of additional setting up and administrative duties.

To ensure the parents feel part of the club and promote the benefits of the club to the parents. To ensure there is good communication flow between the parents, manager and committee

Commitment

1 hour per week and 3 hours at AGM/EGM

Responsibilities

- 1. To manage communication between the committee and the squad's parents
- 2. To manage communication between the manager and the squad's parents
- 3. To ensure attendance of at least 2 people from the squad attend the AGM/EGM
- 4. To promote the club in a good light to parents and promote the respect criteria
- 5. To circulate news of events, encourage attendance and engage with families.

Constraints

The manager is responsible for the above however the Reps. are there to ensure the manager maximises the coaching time and therefore player development.
